

BREEZE HAPPY WITH THRUXTON TEST PACE

Michelin Ginetta G50 title contender Carl Breeze aims to challenge for three race wins during the second round of the season at Thruxton circuit next weekend (25th and 26th April) after lapping with the second fastest time during official testing at the Hampshire track last week.

Currently top of the championship standings following his two wins and a second place finish at Brands Hatch two weeks ago, the race ace from King`s Lynn in Norfolk was in very good form at Thruxton for the official pre-event test.

After getting adjusted to the 2.35-mile circuit during the first 45-minute session, Carl set the second fastest time on very old tyres. For the second session Carl chose not to use any brand new tyres unlike some of his rivals and again he set the second fastest time ending up only 0.090 secs slower than test pace setter Frank Wrathall.

The Bluechip.co.uk-backed racer commented “In both sessions we ran old tyres and concentrated on fine tuning the car, I believe that out of the top six cars our tyres were the worst, so to end up less than 0.1 second off the quickest driver gives us great confidence going into next weekend. This is by far the quickest circuit that we visit on the BTCC tour and with an average speed for the lap topping 110 mph; it requires precision driving and full concentration to get a fast laptime. We will see where we end up after qualifying where the three fastest laps determine the grid slots for each race, I`m feeling relaxed and I`m sure we will do well.”
